CATEGORIES OF INTEREST

- (a) Other paid jobs and whether I intend to continue to hold them if elected.

I left permanent paid employment as a pension fund manager at JPMorgan in March 2008 to work on issues affecting residents of West Worcestershire.

I have been self-employed as a consultant since 2008, working on an occasional basis, and I do not intend to seek any further consultancy work.

I am in my third year of a three year term as Non-Executive Director and Vice Chair of the Social Investment Business, an organisation which helps charities and social enterprises win public sector contracts. The registered address is 6, St. Andrew Street, 5th floor, London, EC4A 3AE. I am contracted to work three days a month. If elected, provided it does not conflict or interfere in any way with my role as a backbench Member of Parliament, I intend to complete my term.

- (b) The existence of positions of responsibility, even if unpaid, in other organisations and whether I intend to continue to hold them if elected.

I am Vice Chair of the Governors at Hallow Church of England Primary School. The role is unpaid. I sit on the Human Resources Committee. I am a Local Authority governor and my four year term expires in 2012. I do not intend to seek to be reappointed to a further term.

- (c) Relevant financial interests, and whether I intend to continue to hold them, if elected:

(i) Directorships. I hold an unremunerated directorship in my own consultancy business. I do not intend to take on any other unremunerated directorships and I will not be seeking any consultancy work.

(ii) Clients. I am not providing any services to clients at the point of this Declaration, nor am I seeking any new clients.

(iii) Land and Property. Apart from property occupied by myself and my family, I own no interest in any further property.

(iv) Shareholdings:

From my previous employment as a pension fund manager, I own deferred shares and shares in JPMorgan. I have no plans to add to this shareholding and usually sell the shares as soon as they vest. I do not receive a pension from my 22 years of service at JPMorgan, but I have saved for my old age, including in a Self Invested Pension Plan, the JPMorgan Chase UK Retirement Fund Trust, the JPMorgan UK Pension Plan Trust, JPMorgan 1998 Employee Trust, JPMF Japanese Smaller Company Trust, JPMorgan US Discovery Trust and JPMorgan UK Smaller Companies Trust. These are all long term investments, although they may be rebalanced. None of these plans hold declarable shareholdings.

- (d) Tax matters: I support the next Conservative government's requirement that anyone who sits in either house will be required by law to be a full UK taxpayer. I confirm that, for the tax year 2008/09, I have not claimed to be, or been treated as not resident, not ordinarily resident or non-domiciled in the UK for tax purposes.
